What to Expect

Before:

- Make needed transportation arrangements
- Do not wear contacts

During:

- Your OCLI Vision specialist will apply anesthetic eye drops for comfort
- Take an optional light sedative to relax

After:

- Protective shields will ensure your eyes can begin healing
- Close your eyes to give them a rest
- Do not touch, rub, or strain your eyes
- Expect to return to normal activities after one or two days
- Your vision will continue to improve over a few weeks

It is important to continue scheduling annual eye exams with your primary eye doctor. This is a proactive way to check that your eyes are healthy and functioning properly.

Vision Correction Treatments at OCLI Vision:

Custom Bladeless LASIK



This procedure uses wavefront technology to measure how light waves travel through your eye. Using this data, your surgeon can provide a laser vision-correction procedure that is completely personalized for your needs.

Topography - Guided Bladeless LASIK

Contoura Vision is the latest personalized approach to LASIK. Because this custom procedure measures and reshapes the structure of your cornea, it is especially helpful for patients with astigmatism.

Photorefractive Keratectomy (PRK)

In PRK procedures, an excimer laser is used to reshape the curvature of the eye. PRK is often best suited for patients with thinner corneas.

Monovision LASIK

In Monovision LASIK, one eye is fully treated for distance vision while the other remains slightly nearsighted. This approach may allow you to maintain your ability to read without glasses as your eyes age.
